What did the framers intend?

Most intended for the selection of the president to be based on the popular wishes of the citizenry.

What did the framers intend?

Most intended for the selection of the president to be based on the popular wishes of the citizenry.

But also expected the electors to exercise their own discretion. (When they have done so, the people have been displeased.)

None of the framers' concerns are relevant today

 \succ Information is widely available to citizens.

Congressional selection of the President is not under consideration.

The people do not want electors exercising their own discretion (and electors almost never do).









The Electoral College Decreases Voter Turnout









A Divided Vote: 1984


Without the Electoral College, our presidents would all be chosen by a couple of big states like California, New York, and Texas.






Small States Do Not Vote as a Bloc




Candidates focus their time in "swing states," not small states.

Virginia gets 13 electors









Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to abolish the electoral college and to provide for the direct popular election of the President and Vice President of the United States.




Timeline of Constitutional Amendments




